

2026 UEFA YOUTH LEAGUE™ FINAL TOURNAMENT GROUP SALES TICKETING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

A. INTRODUCTION

1. Scope

The following Group Sales Ticketing Terms and Conditions for the 2026 UEFA Youth League™ Final Tournament (the “Terms and Conditions”) are designed to ensure a fair, correct and efficient process for distribution and use of Tickets to the 2026 UEFA Youth League™ Final Tournament purchased in the UEFA Group Sales. The distribution and use of such Tickets are subject to the following Terms and Conditions and any other applicable laws or regulations (as defined below under “Applicable Laws” and “Regulations”) pertaining to access and usage of the Stade de La Tuilière.

2. Definitions

B. ALLOCATION OF TICKETS

3. General Rules

3.1. For the purposes of these Terms and Conditions:

- a. LS VAUD FOOT SA has been appointed by UEFA to host and stage the Tournament and is the organiser of the Tournament;
 - b. UC3 is the exclusive entity responsible for the exploitation of the commercial rights, including the sales of Tickets, in respect of the Tournament. LS VAUD FOOT SA has been appointed as the seller of the Tickets for the Tournament on behalf of UC3; and
 - c. UEFA Events SA carries out certain operational tasks in relation to the Tournament.
- 3.2. All Tickets are sold subject to these Terms and Conditions and LS VAUD FOOT SA's ticketing terms and conditions, which are available at <https://weezevent.com/fr-ch/cgv-weezticket/>.
- 3.3. Applicants may apply for the Ticket(s) on the Online Ticket Sales Platform in accordance with the instructions of UEFA Parties and/or LS VAUD FOOT SA and within the application deadlines communicated to the Applicants.
- 3.4. Tickets will be available in such categories and at such prices as notified to the Applicant by LS VAUD FOOT SA.

4. Payment

- 4.1. Payment for the Ticket(s) can be made by such methods indicated to the Applicant on the Online Ticket Sales Platform.
- 4.2. The Applicant's bank will apply its own currency exchange rates (if applicable) and may levy additional fees or charges for payment of the Ticket(s). Applicants shall contact their respective payment bank before submitting a request for Tickets in order to enquire about their payment bank's exchange rates, charges or fees. UEFA Events SA and LS VAUD FOOT SA shall not be responsible for any such exchange rates, fees or charges levied by Applicant's payment bank in respect of payment for the Ticket(s).

5. Offer Acceptance

- 5.1. The agreement between LS VAUD FOOT SA and the relevant Applicant for the purchase of the Ticket(s) will be concluded (under these Terms and Conditions) only after the:
 - a. if applicable, successful processing of the payment for the Ticket(s) indicated in the Request, in accordance with Article 4; and
 - b. acceptance of the Applicant's offer by LS VAUD FOOT SA by way of submission of the Notification to the Applicant.
- 5.2. Successful Applicants are requested to review their Notification for any inaccuracies, in particular with regards to their Ticket(s) quantity, price, and category. Any inaccuracies must be immediately notified to UEFA Events SA and/or LS VAUD FOOT SA.

6. Allocation of Tickets by the Applicant

- 6.1. Each Ticket (including the relevant seating information of block, row and seat number) will be linked to the Successful Applicant and the Successful Applicant shall ensure that it maintains a record of all Ticket Holders to whom it has allocated Tickets (and what Tickets it has allocated). Ticket Holders shall provide their personal data to the Successful Applicant, who shall subsequently, if requested by UEFA Parties (which

may be via LS VAUD FOOT SA) transfer their first name, last name and e-mail address, along with any other information required under Applicable Laws or at the request of the competent authorities, to UEFA Events SA and/or LS VAUD FOOT SA by no later than two (2) days before the date of the relevant Match. The Successful Applicant shall ensure that all such personal data is correct and available and provided in accordance with the instructions of UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the relevant authorities for matters related to safety and security at the Match.

- 6.2. The Successful Applicant shall ensure that the collection, processing and transfer of the Ticket Holder's data pursuant to Article 6.1 is carried out in compliance with the Successful Applicant's applicable laws, including in relation to obtaining any required consents from the Ticket Holders.
- 6.3. The Successful Applicant shall ensure that the Ticket Holders comply with these Terms and Conditions. Tickets will be distributed to the Ticket Holders in accordance with the rules established and communicated to the Ticket Holders by the Successful Applicant. UEFA Parties and LS VAUD FOOT SA shall not be liable for any problems arising from or damages sustained as a result of the distribution process implemented by the Successful Applicant. Any information requests regarding the distribution of Tickets should be addressed directly to the Successful Applicant.
- 6.4. The Successful Applicant shall assume the risk of any Ticket loss, damage or late delivery, unless UEFA Parties and/or LS VAUD FOOT SA can be proven to have acted with gross negligence or be at fault. Any Ticket loss shall be notified to UEFA Parties and/or LS VAUD FOOT SA without delay. LS VAUD FOOT SA shall be entitled to disable the relevant Tickets immediately following receipt of such notification.
- 6.5. Tickets shall remain the property of UEFA at all times.

7. Distribution of Tickets

- 7.1. Tickets will be distributed to the Successful Applicants in one of the following ways, with such method to be determined at UEFA Parties' and LS VAUD FOOT SA's discretion:
 - a. by virtue of "Print@Home" e-tickets. Where Tickets are remitted in this manner, a duly printed hard copy of the e-ticket or presentation of such e-ticket on a mobile device must be physically presented by each Ticket Holder at the Stadium. Where the Successful Applicant has been notified that the Ticket(s) will be remitted via "Print@home" e-tickets, it is the responsibility of the Ticket Holder to print such e-tickets or show such e-tickets on a mobile device at the Stadium. UEFA Parties and/or LS VAUD FOOT SA shall be under no obligation to print such e-tickets for the Successful Applicant and/or Ticket Holder or to provide any alternative paper Ticket(s);
 - b. by personal pick-up by the Successful Applicant's representative (the details of whom must be notified to UEFA Parties and/or LS VAUD FOOT SA in advance). Where personal pick-up is applicable, UEFA Parties and/or LS VAUD FOOT SA will notify the respective Successful Applicant by email, providing the exact details of the Ticket collection point (which shall be at such location as notified to the Successful Applicant by UEFA Parties and/or LS VAUD FOOT SA). In order to collect such Tickets, the Successful Applicant's representative must present a valid identification document (passport or national identity card) for themselves.
- 7.2. Defective e-tickets" Ticket(s) such as for example, with illegible printing or missing any part of the printed area of the Ticket, will be rejected at the entrance to the Stadium.

UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and the Stadium Owner shall not be responsible for defective, lost or stolen Ticket(s) and will accept no obligation to reprint or refund any such Ticket(s).

- 7.3. Defective paper Ticket(s) such as, for example, Tickets with illegible data (date, time, etc.) or missing seat information, or Ticket(s) damaged during the delivery to the Successful Applicant, shall be notified to UEFA Parties and/or LS VAUD FOOT SA immediately following their delivery or personal pick-up. Defective Ticket(s) will be replaced free of charge provided that the original defective Ticket(s) are returned/remitted to UEFA Parties and/or LS VAUD FOOT SA in their original condition. UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and the Stadium Owner shall not be responsible for lost, stolen, damaged or destroyed Ticket(s) after their delivery to the Successful Applicant. In particular UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and the Stadium Owner shall not be liable to refund any Ticket(s) or to re-print Ticket(s).

C. USE OF TICKETS

8. Prohibited Use of the Ticket(s)

- 8.1. Tickets from the Successful Applicant's allocation are for the personal use of the Ticket Holder to whom such Ticket has been allocated by the Successful Applicant. Any resale or transfer or offer for resale or transfer of the Ticket(s), whether for free or for consideration, is strictly prohibited without the prior written approval (email sufficient) of UEFA Parties (to be given at UEFA Parties' sole discretion).
- 8.2. Unless authorised in advance and in writing (email sufficient) by UEFA Parties, the Ticket(s) shall not be:
- a. used for any promotion, advertising, fundraising, auction, raffle or any other similar commercial or non-commercial purposes;
 - b. used as a prize (or part of a prize) in any contest, competition, (promotional) game of chance, lottery or sweepstake;
 - c. combined with and sold as part of any package of goods or services; or
 - d. combined with and sold as part of any travel or hospitality package (for example combining flights, hotels and/or food and drink with the Ticket(s)).
- 8.3. Ticket Holders shall not:
- a. run any advertisements or promotions relating to UEFA Parties, the UEFA Youth League™, the Tournament or the Match(es);
 - b. advertise, promote, give away, distribute, sell or offer for sale any product or service from any part of the Stadium or via the display of overt commercial messages on clothing worn or items brought into the Stadium; or
 - c. exploit any marketing or promotional opportunities in relation to the Ticket(s).

For the avoidance of doubt, no branding, which may be aimed at promotional or marketing purposes whatsoever, may be displayed by any Ticket Holder at the Stadium.

- 8.4. Ticket(s) acquired or used in breach of Article 8 and/or Article 13 of these Terms and Conditions shall be void with no right to a refund and any person seeking to use such Ticket(s) will be deemed a trespasser and will be refused entry or be evicted from the

Stadium, with no right to a refund, and may be liable to further legal action. Any unauthorised sale or transfer of the Ticket(s) may be reported to the police and/or other relevant authorities.

- 8.5. Any breach of these Terms and Conditions, any Applicable Laws and/or of any Regulations shall entitle LS VAUD FOOT SA to cancel and invalidate the Ticket and any other Tickets that have been purchased by and/or allocated to the Successful Applicant, for the same or any other Match with no right to a refund.

9. Entrance to the Stadium

- 9.1. Access to the Stadium will be permitted during such hours as notified to the Ticket Holder by the Successful Applicant who distributed the Ticket or as published on <https://www.lausanne-sport.ch/uefayouthleague>. Ticket Holders are obliged to ensure that they keep themselves informed about possible alterations of the Match.

- 9.2. Entrance to the Stadium shall be:

- a. subject to compliance with:
 - i. these Terms and Conditions;
 - ii. the Stadium Rules;
 - iii. any sanitary measures or policies in place;
 - iv. all Applicable Laws (whether statutory or otherwise and including health and safety requirements and any sanitary measures) governing access or presence at the Stadium, attendance at the Match, use of the Tickets, general safety certificate and any special safety certificate applying to the Stadium, issued by any authority that has jurisdiction or authority in relation to the holding of the Match at the Stadium; and
- b. authorised upon presentation of a valid Ticket per person (regardless of age) and, upon request, proof of identity with valid photograph (passport or national identity card).

- 9.3. Any breach of these Terms and Conditions by the Successful Applicant/Ticket Holder (as applicable) shall result in the Successful Applicant/Ticket Holder being deemed a trespasser in case of entry to the Stadium and shall give UEFA Parties and/or LS VAUD FOOT SA the right to eject said Successful Applicant/Ticket Holder from the relevant Stadium.

- 9.4. Ticket Holders leaving the Stadium will not be re-admitted.

10. Conduct at the Stadium

- 10.1. For safety and security purposes, all Ticket Holders, if and when so requested by stewards, safety personnel and/or any other legally authorised persons representing UEFA Parties and/or LS VAUD FOOT SA, shall:

- a. produce a valid Ticket together with proof of identity with valid photograph (passport or national identity card);
- b. submit to inspections, body checks and examinations – including through the use of technical aids – to ensure that they are not in possession of dangerous, prohibited or unauthorised items. Safety personnel, stewards or police shall be entitled to search any person's clothing and their belongings; and

- c. comply with all instructions and guidelines issued by such persons;
 - d. comply with all sanitary measures and policies in place at the Stadium and follow any and all instructions from safety personnel, stewards and/or police and/or any other duly authorised persons at the Stadium in relation to sanitary and hygiene measures; and
 - e. be subject to additional safety controls inside the Stadium, as the case may arise.
- 10.2. It shall be strictly forbidden inside the Stadium to express, display or disseminate of any insulting, discriminatory, racist, xenophobic, sexist, religious, political or other illegal/prohibited messages.
- 10.3. The Stadium Rules contain detailed lists of prohibited items and conduct and each Ticket Holder shall fully comply with any restrictions contained therein. Abbreviated versions of these Terms and Conditions and/or the Stadium Rules, or simple icons illustrating prohibited items or conduct, may also be included on the Ticket and must be fully complied with by the Ticket Holder.
- 10.4. Without limitation, it is strictly forbidden to do any of the following inside the Stadium:
- a. occupy or access areas which are closed to the public or for which access is unauthorised in accordance with the relevant Ticket category held by the Ticket Holder;
 - b. restrict or loiter in areas open to traffic, footpaths and roadways, entrances and exits to visitor areas and emergency exits; and/or
 - c. engage in any other conduct which may endanger any person at the Stadium.

The above list is not exhaustive. Ticket Holders should refer to the Stadium Rules for more information on the required conduct.

- 10.5. Fans supporting the teams participating in the Match may not be segregated at the Stadium and each Ticket Holder agrees to behave responsibly and in line with the safety and security guidelines communicated by UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner.

11. Sound and Image Recordings

- 11.1. Ticket Holders attending the Match take note that their voice, image and likeness recorded during their time in the Stadium ("Recordings") may be used, free of charge, in any image, sound and audiovisual material in connection with the Match, either simultaneously or at a later date. UEFA Parties or third parties engaged or otherwise authorised in each case (e.g., broadcasting, press, individuals/influencers) create Recordings for the purpose and on the basis of their legitimate interest of public reporting and promotion of the Tournament pursuant to Art. 31 para. 1 of the Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection (FADP). Recordings may be processed, exploited and publicly reproduced by UEFA Parties as well as third parties authorised in each case (e.g. broadcasting, press, individuals/influencers) within the scope of the same legitimate interest pursuant to Art. 31 para. 1 of the FADP.
- 11.2. Ticket Holders attending the Match shall not collect, record, use or disseminate any sound, image, recording or depiction of the Stadium and/or the Match (including any results, statistics, information or other data about the Match in whole or in part) ("Content") over the internet, radio, television or any other current or future media – or assist any other persons in doing so – other than for personal, private and non-commercial use. Any such personal, private and non-commercial use is at the Ticket

Holder's own risk and, for the avoidance of doubt, requires the Ticket Holder to clear all necessary rights for such use. Examples of personal, private non-commercial use include sharing (limited) Content (by means of physical or electronic media) with the Ticket Holder's close friends and family but shall not include any use of Content:

- a. on a live/near-live basis;
- b. in any manner intended to make available any aspect of the Match to the public;
- c. on webpages or social media accounts (save for any closed social media account accessible by the person's close friends and family only);
- d. to promote, sponsor, endorse or sell products/services;
- e. to generate any form of commercial gain or remuneration (whether monetary or not); or
- f. on any form of physical or electronic media in any manner that suggests an official association with UEFA Parties and/or the Match.

UEFA Parties reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to determine whether any use of Content constitutes personal, private and non-commercial use. For the avoidance of doubt, UEFA Parties and any authorised third party is entitled to delete, or cause to be deleted, any images transmitted or publicly displayed in breach of this clause and to bring any other claim against the responsible person (collecting, recording, using or disseminating as described above) in a judicial or extrajudicial proceeding.

11.3 All rights in relation to any Content created by Ticket Holders shall be owned by UEFA, save that UEFA Parties hereby grant Ticket Holders a non-exclusive licence to use such Content for the personal, private and non-commercial uses described in Article 11.2 above. In this respect, each Ticket Holder hereby irrevocably and unconditionally transfers and assigns to UEFA Parties, free of charge, all rights (including all intellectual property rights) in relation to any such Content for the full period of such rights. In any jurisdiction where such transfer/assignment does not take effect, the Ticket Holder hereby grants to UEFA Parties, free of charge, a perpetual, worldwide, unrestricted, irrevocable, exclusive, transferable, sub-licensable, royalty-free licence to use such Content for any and all purposes. If requested by UEFA Parties, the Ticket Holder shall do all things reasonably necessary to give effect to this Article 11.3.

11.4 To ensure the safety of the public and effective law enforcement, the Stadium and, in part, its surroundings are monitored with a closed-circuit television system in accordance with Art. 31 para. 1 lit. f of the FADP generally operated by the Stadium Owner regarding the Match. The respective recordings are treated confidentially by the Stadium Owner and in compliance with applicable data protection law but can serve as evidence in particular in the event of suspicion and/or the occurrence of criminal offences; the Stadium Owner may transfer their recordings to the competent public safety authorities in these cases. In addition, the competent public safety authorities may also use video surveillance equipment on match days on their own responsibility to avert danger and prosecute offenders in accordance with the applicable legal provisions.

D. MISCELLANEOUS

12. Liability

12.1. In the event that UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner are in breach of their obligations (under these Terms and Conditions or otherwise), UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner shall only be responsible for such loss or damage suffered by the Ticket Holder which was reasonably foreseeable as a result of the breach. UEFA Parties and/or the Stadium Owner shall not be responsible for any loss or damage that is not reasonably foreseeable or contemplated

at the time the Applicant entered into a contract pursuant to these Terms and Conditions.

- 12.2. Notwithstanding Article 12.1 and subject to Article 12.5, UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner are not liable for any business losses and UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner will have no liability to any Ticket Holder for any loss of profit, loss of business, business interruption, or loss of business opportunity.
- 12.3. Subject to Article 12.5 in any event, to the maximum extent permitted by law, UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner hereby exclude any liability for loss, damage or injury to a Ticket Holder and/or their property, including (but not limited to) any indirect or consequential loss or damage, including (but not limited to) loss of enjoyment or travel or accommodation costs, regardless of whether the loss or damage: (a) would arise in the ordinary course of events; (b) is reasonably foreseeable; or (c) is in the contemplation of the parties, or otherwise.
- 12.4. Subject to Article 12.5, UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner shall not be responsible for any interruptions and/or restrictions to the view of the Match caused by virtue of (i) their position at the Stadium and/or (ii) the actions of other spectators.
- 12.5. Notwithstanding any provision in these Terms and Conditions, UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner do not seek to exclude or limit their liability: (a) for fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation; (b) for death or personal injury caused by UEFA Parties', LS VAUD FOOT SA's and/or the Stadium Owner's negligence or the negligence of any of their officers, employees or agents; or (c) for any other matter for which it is not possible to exclude or limit liability by law.
- 12.6. Nothing stated or implied in these Terms and Conditions will affect the Ticket Holder's statutory rights.

13. Unauthorised Spectators

- 13.1. Ticket Holders are permitted to attend the Match only provided that:
 - a. they are not an Excluded Person (as defined in Article 13.2);
 - b. the Ticket has been obtained in accordance with these Terms and Conditions; and
 - c. where the Ticket Holder travels to the country in which the Tournament is taking place, they have complied with any requirements which are in place regarding entry into such country (including but not limited to any travel and entry requirements, including any requirement to obtain a valid visa, imposed under Applicable Laws).

For the avoidance of doubt, UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner shall not be liable for any loss or damage suffered by a Ticket Holder should they fail to comply with the provisions of this Article 13.1 and/or, where required, fail to obtain the necessary documents.

- 13.2. For the purpose of this Article 13, "Excluded Person" means:
 - a. any person banned from membership of the fan club for their national football team;

- b. any person subject to an administrative or judicial football ban under the Laws of Switzerland;
- c. any person banned by UEFA, FIFA, any football governing body or otherwise, from travelling to or attending an association football match;
- d. any person banned by UEFA, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner from attending events at the Stadium;
- e. any person who is deemed by the participating clubs in the Match to be a person to whom Tickets should not be allocated (including, but not limited to, persons who have been issued with a stadium ban by the respective participating clubs);
- f. any person who is deemed by the relevant public authorities to be a person to whom Tickets should not be allocated for safety and security reasons; and
- g. any person who has breached or is in breach of these Terms and Conditions.

14. Privacy

14.1. By purchasing Tickets, the Successful Applicant:

- a. acknowledges and agrees that the personal data provided during the Ticket purchase process and, if applicable, the name(s) of their Guest(s) submitted pursuant to these Terms and Conditions are processed by LS VAUD FOOT SA and will be entered into a database owned by LS VAUD FOOT SA for the purposes of the organisation and running of the Tournament (in particular in connection with the Ticket sales and/or any relevant safety and security measures); and
- b. warrants that they have obtained the consent of their Guest(s) for the processing of their data for the purposes specified in point a. above.

14.2. The Buyer acknowledges that:

- a. LS VAUD FOOT SA's ticketing partner is Weezevent Switzerland Sàrl, Rue Pré-du-Marché 23, 1004 Lausanne and LS VAUD FOOT SA will transfer such personal data of the Buyer and their Ticket Holders to Weezevent Switzerland Sàrl to enable them to provide the required ticketing services to LS VAUD FOOT SA; and
- b. LS VAUD FOOT SA may transfer the Successful Applicant's personal data (and the name(s) of their Ticket Holder(s), if applicable) to UEFA Parties and/or the Stadium Owner (and their agents) and to LS VAUD FOOT SA's and UEFA Parties' service providers and third parties, in particular to Stadium security and access service providers, as well as to the relevant authorities for the above mentioned purposes, and in the performance of their activities

14.3. Personal data provided by the Successful Applicant during the Ticket purchase process is stored and processed in accordance with LS VAUD FOOT SA's privacy policy. This policy can be found at <https://www.lausanne-sport.ch/traitement-des-donnees/>.

14.4. By providing their personal information during the Ticket purchase process, each Successful Applicant acknowledges and agrees, and shall ensure that their Ticket Holder(s) acknowledges and agrees, that they have understood,

15. Unforeseen Circumstances

- 15.1. UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner reserve the right to make alterations to the time, date and location of the Tournament and/or the Matches due to unforeseen extraordinary circumstances, including but not limited to reasons of force majeure, safety and/or security reasons or other decisions made by any competent authority which have a major impact on the Matches being played at the Stadium.
- 15.2. In the event of cancellation, abandonment, rescheduling, replaying of the Matches, or in the event of a change of venue, reduction of Stadium capacity or the playing of the relevant Match behind closed doors, the Successful Applicant will be bound by the Refund Policy in respect of any refunds of the Tickets purchased by the Successful Applicant provided however that:
- a. any refunds may be made only to the Successful Applicant (and not to the Ticket Holder) and only up to the Purchase Price paid by such Successful Applicant for the Ticket(s), and shall not, for the avoidance of doubt, entitle the Successful Applicant to a refund of any costs and expenses incurred by the Successful Buyer or Ticket Holder in relation to travel or accommodation;
 - b. subject to the foregoing and Article 12, UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner will not have any liability to the Successful Applicant or any Ticket Holder on account of any such cancellation, abandonment, rescheduling, replay, change of venue, reduction of Stadium capacity or the playing of the relevant Match behind closed doors or other failure or deficiency in the conduct of the Matches.

16. Severability and Amendment

- 16.1. UEFA Events SA reserves the right to case these Terms and Conditions if deemed necessary, including to ensure proper and safe staging of the Match at the Stadium. LS VAUD FOOT SA will notify the Applicant or Successful Applicant (as applicable) of any material changes via the contact details provided by the Applicant or Successful Applicant (as applicable) during the Ticket purchase and the Applicant or Successful Applicant (as applicable) will have the choice to consent to such material changes or to withdraw their application or withdraw from the agreement concluded with LS VAUD FOOT SA.
- 16.2. Should any provisions of these Terms and Conditions be declared void, ineffective, illegal or unenforceable by any competent court, regulator or authority:
- a. the remainder of these Terms and Conditions shall remain in effect as if such void, ineffective, illegal or unenforceable provision(s) had not been included; and
 - b. where required and/or permitted under Applicable Laws, the invalid provision shall be replaced with a provision, which closely approximates the economic purpose of such invalid provision.

17. Authentic Text

- 17.1. These Terms and Conditions have been drafted in the English language. In the event of any discrepancy between the English and any translated version, the English version shall prevail.

18. General

- 18.1. The Ticket Holder consents to these Terms and Conditions by accepting the Ticket provided to them by the Successful Applicant (i.e. the Successful Applicant shall ensure that the Ticket Holder(s) understands, agrees with and will conform to the Terms and Conditions). If the Ticket Holder(s) is under the age of 18 each Applicant confirms that they have received proper consent to these Terms and Conditions from the Ticket Holder's appropriate parent or guardian under the Applicable Laws of Switzerland.
- 18.2. These Terms and Conditions and the terms and conditions of LS VAUD FOOT SA constitute the entire agreement between the parties and no party shall have any claim or remedy in respect of any statement, representation, warranty or undertaking, made by or on behalf of any other party in relation to these Terms and Conditions or the terms and conditions of LS VAUD FOOT SA which is not already set out in these Terms and Conditions or the terms and conditions of LS VAUD FOOT SA. In the event of any conflict between these Terms and Conditions and the terms and conditions of LS VAUD FOOT SA, these Terms and Conditions shall prevail.
- 18.3. Save where precluded under any Applicable Laws, the laws of Switzerland govern these Terms and Conditions. The parties agree that, save where precluded under any Applicable Laws, the courts of Nyon shall have exclusive jurisdiction, save that if the Successful Applicant is deemed to be a consumer for the purposes of any Applicable Laws, any proceedings arising out of or in respect of these Terms and Conditions can be brought in the courts of the place of residence of the domicile of such Successful Applicant.
