

## **2026 UEFA YOUTH LEAGUE™ FINAL TOURNAMENT TICKETING TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR FOOTBALL SCOUTS**

### **A. INTRODUCTION**

#### **1. Scope**

The following 2026 UEFA Youth League™ Final Tournament ticketing terms and conditions (the “Terms and Conditions”) are designed to ensure a fair, correct and efficient process for the request and use of Tickets for football scouts to the 2026 UEFA Youth League™ Final Tournament in Lausanne (“the Tournament”). The allocation and use of such Tickets are subject to the following Terms and Conditions and any other applicable laws or regulations (as defined below under “Applicable Laws” and “Regulations”) pertaining to access and usage of the Stadium.

#### **2. Definitions**

<b>Applicable Laws</b>	all laws, statutes, common law, regulations, ordinances, codes, rules, guidelines, orders, permits, tariffs and approvals, including those relating to the environment, health and safety or sanitary measures, of any governmental or local authority that apply to the Applicant, Guest and/or Ticket Holder, or the subject matter of these Terms and Conditions.
<b>Applicant</b>	any natural person over 18 years of age who has legal capacity to apply and enter into an agreement for the allocation of Tickets to the Tournament in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
<b>Application Form</b>	the electronic form filled-in and submitted by an Applicant online via the FAME Portal being the request of the Applicant to be purchase the Ticket(s) for the Purchase Price.
<b>FAME Portal</b>	UEFA’s online Football Administration and Management Environment, the specific URL of which will be communicated to the Applicant by UEFA, on which Applicants can apply for Tickets by submitting the Application Form.
<b>Guest</b>	an individual accompanying the Applicant to the Match to whom Tickets may be transferred by the Applicant in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
<b>LS VAUD FOOT SA</b>	LS VAUD FOOT SA of Stade de La Tuilière, Route de Romanel 10, 1018 Lausanne, who is the organiser of the Tournament under Applicable Laws and the seller of the Tickets for the Tournament.
<b>Match</b>	any official match played as part of the Tournament.
<b>Notification</b>	the email notification of acceptance by UEFA (subject to payment of the Purchase Price by the Applicant) of the Applicant’s offer to purchase and/or be allocated Tickets, with confirmation of the allocation of the Ticket(s) indicated in such

	Notification, as sent by UEFA Parties to the email address provided by the Applicant in the Application Form.
<b>Purchase Price</b>	the total purchase price for the Ticket(s) selected by the Applicant, inclusive of all relevant taxes.
<b>Refund Policy</b>	<p>the <a href="#">Refund Policy</a> of UEFA Events SA as applicable from time to time.</p> <p>For the purposes of the Refund Policy and any Ticket(s) purchased under these Terms and Conditions, the term “Buyer” in the Refund Policy shall refer to an “Applicant” (as defined in these Terms and Conditions) who has been allocated and who has purchased Tickets, and the terms of the Refund Policy shall be construed accordingly.</p>
<b>Regulations</b>	<p>means, without limitation, the terms of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Stadium Rules; and/or</li><li>- UEFA’s statutes and regulations applicable for the Tournament.</li></ul>
<b>Stadium</b>	the entire premises of the Stade de La Tuilière, Route de Romanel 10, 1018 Lausanne, including all areas which require a Ticket (or other access device, if applicable) to gain access.
<b>Stadium Owner</b>	the owner of the Stadium and any operator or lessee of the Stadium.
<b>Stadium Rules</b>	<p>the Stadium Rules as applicable to the Tournament which can be accessed at:</p> <p><a href="https://www.lausanne-sport.ch/uefayouthleague">https://www.lausanne-sport.ch/uefayouthleague</a></p>
<b>Ticket</b>	the paper, electronic print@home or mobile ticket held by the Ticket Holder which (subject to these Terms and Conditions) grants the Ticket Holder the right to attend the relevant Match on the relevant day as indicated on such Ticket.
<b>Ticket Holder</b>	any person who is in actual and legitimate possession of a Ticket including, without limitation, successful Applicants and Guests (as applicable).
<b>Tournament</b>	the final tournament of the UEFA Youth League™ 2025/2026 scheduled to be held at the Stadium on 17 April and 20 April 2026.
<b>UC3</b>	UEFA Club Competitions SA (trading as UC3) whose offices are located at Route de Genève 46, 1260 Nyon 2, Switzerland. UC3 is the commercial joint venture between its shareholders (UEFA and European Football Clubs (formally known as ECA)) and is responsible for the commercialisation of UEFA’s club competitions.

<b>UEFA</b>	Union des Associations Européennes de Football whose offices are located at Route de Genève 46, 1260 Nyon 2, Switzerland.
<b>UEFA Events SA</b>	UEFA Events SA of Route de Genève 46, 1260 Nyon 2, Switzerland.
<b>UEFA Parties</b>	UEFA, UEFA Events SA and UC3.

## **B. SALE OF TICKETS**

### **3. General Application Rules**

- 3.1. For the purposes of these Terms and Conditions:
  - a. LS VAUD FOOT SA has been appointed by UEFA to host and stage the Tournament and is the organiser of the Tournament;
  - b. UC3 is the exclusive entity responsible for the exploitation of the commercial rights, including the sales of Tickets, in respect of the Tournament. LS VAUD FOOT SA has been appointed as the seller of the Tickets for the Tournament on behalf of UC3; and
  - c. UEFA Events SA carries out certain operational tasks in relation to the Tournament.
- 3.2. Applicants may apply for the Ticket(s) via the FAME Portal within the application deadlines communicated to the Applicants. Applicants may apply for a maximum of two (2) Tickets per Match.
- 3.3. By clicking the confirmation button/field in the Application Form on the FAME Portal, the Applicant acknowledges that they have read, understood and agree to comply with these Terms and Conditions and LS VAUD FOOT SA's ticketing terms and conditions, which are available at <https://weezevent.com/fr-ch/cgv-weezticket/>
- 3.4. Tickets will be available in one category as indicated on the FAME Portal, however, UEFA Parties reserves the right to relocate the Ticket Holders at the Stadium.
- 3.5. In the Application Form, the Applicant is required to provide their surname, first name, date of birth, organisation they represent, e-mail address and phone number. The Applicant is also required to upload the details of their scout identification document. The Applicant shall provide the surname and first name of their Guest (if applicable) upon request by UEFA Parties.
- 3.6. It is the sole responsibility of the Applicant to ensure that:
  - a. the Application Form has been filled-in completely with all required personal details;
  - b. the acceptance of these Terms and Conditions as required by UEFA Parties in the Application Form is properly given by clicking the respective box(es) in the Application Form; and
  - c. the Application Form is properly submitted to UEFA Parties. An email with the Application Form receipt confirmation will be issued by UEFA Parties and sent automatically to the email address provided by the Applicant in the Application Form. If the Applicant does not receive this confirmation they should report it to UEFA Parties without delay. This affirmation-email shall not be construed as an acceptance of the Applicant's offer, but be subject to the availability of the Tickets requested, the acceptance of the Applicant's offer

according to Article 5 below and the observance of particular circumstances (e.g. safety or health aspects).

- 3.7. Timely submission of the correctly filled-in Application Form, properly received by UEFA Parties, constitutes an offer of the Applicant to conclude an agreement to be allocated the Ticket(s) indicated in the Application Form, which may be accepted by UEFA in accordance with Article 5.1.

#### **4. Payment**

- 4.1. In the event that the Applicant receives the Notification, payment of the applicable Purchase Price (if any) of the Ticket(s) must be made at the Ticketing Booth at the Stadium during the opening hours of such Ticketing Booth (the details of which shall be notified to the relevant Applicants by UEFA Parties). Payment may be made by such credit/debit cards as indicated at the payment point or by 'Twint'.
- 4.2. The Applicant's bank will apply its own currency exchange rates (if applicable) and may levy additional fees or charges for payment of the Ticket(s). Applicants shall contact their respective payment bank before submitting the Application Form in order to enquire about their payment bank's exchange rates, charges or fees. UEFA Parties and LS VAUD FOOT SA shall not be responsible for any such exchange rates, fees or charges levied by Applicant's payment bank in respect of payment for the Ticket(s).

#### **5. Offer Acceptance**

- 5.1. The agreement between UEFA and the relevant Applicant for the purchase of the Ticket(s) will be concluded (under these Terms and Conditions) only after the;
- a. submission of the Notification to the Applicant; and
  - b. successful processing of the payment for the Ticket(s) indicated in the Application Form, in accordance with Article 4.
- 5.2. Applicants are requested to review their Notification for any inaccuracies, in particular with regards to their Ticket(s) quantity. Any inaccuracies must be immediately notified to UEFA Parties.

#### **6. Distribution of Tickets**

- 6.1. Tickets will be delivered to the Applicants by personal pick-up by the Applicant. UEFA Events SA will notify the respective Applicant by email, providing the exact details of the Ticket collection point as well as the opening times during which the Ticket(s) can be collected. In order to collect such Tickets, the respective Applicant must present a valid scout identification document together with an identification document (passport or national identity card).
- 6.2. Tickets shall remain the property of UEFA SA at all times.
- 6.3. Defective Ticket(s) such as, for example, Tickets with illegible data, missing seat information, or with incorrect personal information printed on the Ticket (if applicable), shall be immediately notified to UEFA Parties upon receipt of the Tickets. UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and the Stadium Owner shall not be responsible for lost, stolen, damaged or destroyed Ticket(s) after their delivery to the successful Applicant.

#### **C. USE OF TICKETS**

##### **7. Prohibited Use of the Ticket(s)**

- 7.1. Except as expressly permitted in Article 7.2, any resale, transfer, offer or advertisement for resale or transfer of the Ticket(s) whether for free or for consideration, is strictly prohibited without the prior written approval of UEFA Parties (to be given at UEFA Parties' sole discretion).
- 7.2. Applicants shall be permitted to transfer the Ticket to their Guest provided that (jointly):
- a. the Applicant will attend the Match together with their Guest (unless otherwise permitted by UEFA Parties);
  - b. each Guest(s) shall attend the Match and shall not resell or transfer their Ticket;
  - c. the Tickets are for their personal use;
  - d. such permitted transfer is free of any consideration; and
  - e. Guests, by accepting the transfer of Tickets from the Applicant, agree to be subject to these Terms and Conditions.
- 7.3. The Ticket(s) shall not be:
- a. used for any promotion, advertising, fundraising, auction, raffle or any other similar commercial or non-commercial purposes;
  - b. used as a prize (or part of a prize) in any contest, competition, (promotional) game of chance, lottery or sweepstake;
  - c. combined with and sold as part of any package of goods or services; or
  - d. combined with and sold as part of any travel or hospitality package (for example combining flights, hotels and/or food and drink with the Ticket(s)).
- 7.4. Ticket Holders shall not:
- a. run any advertisements or promotions relating to UEFA Parties, the UEFA Youth League™, the Tournament or the Match(es);
  - b. advertise, promote, give away, distribute, sell or offer for sale any product or service from any part of the Stadium or via the display of overt commercial messages on clothing worn or items brought into the Stadium; or
  - c. exploit any marketing or promotional opportunities in relation to the Ticket(s).

For the avoidance of doubt, no branding, which may be aimed at promotional or marketing purposes whatsoever, may be displayed by any Ticket Holder at the Stadium.

- 7.5. Ticket(s) acquired or used in breach of this Article 7 and/or Article 12 of these Terms and Conditions shall be void and any person seeking to use such Ticket(s) will be deemed a trespasser and will be refused entry or be evicted from the Stadium and may be liable to further legal action. Any unauthorised sale or transfer of the Ticket(s) may be reported to the police or other relevant authorities.
- 7.6. Any breach of these Terms and Conditions, any Applicable Laws and/or of any Regulations shall entitle UEFA Parties or FC Lausanne to cancel and invalidate the Ticket and any other Ticket(s) for the Tournament that have been allocated to the Ticket Holder with no right to a refund (if applicable).

## **8. Entrance to the Stadium**

- 8.1. Access to the Stadium will be permitted during such hours as specified in the Notification or as published on [www.uefa.com](http://www.uefa.com).
- 8.2. Entrance to the Stadium shall be:
  - a. subject to compliance with:
    - i. these Terms and Conditions;
    - ii. the Stadium Rules;
    - iii. any sanitary measures or policies in place;
    - iv. all Applicable Laws (whether statutory or otherwise and including health and safety requirements and any sanitary measures) governing access or presence at the Stadium, attendance at the Match, use of the Tickets, general safety certificate and any special safety certificate applying to the Stadium, issued by any authority that has jurisdiction or authority in relation to the holding of the Match at the Stadium; and
  - b. authorised upon presentation of a valid Ticket per person (regardless of age) and, upon request, proof of identity with valid photograph (passport or national identity card).
- 8.3. Any breach of these Terms and Conditions by an Applicant/Guest/Ticket Holder shall result in the Applicant/Guest/Ticket Holder being deemed a trespasser and shall give UEFA Parties and LS VAUD FOOT SA the right to eject said Applicant/Guest/Ticket Holder from the Stadium.
- 8.4. Ticket Holders leaving the Stadium will not be re-admitted.

## **9. Conduct at the Stadium**

- 9.1. For safety and security purposes, all persons attending the Match, if and when so requested by stewards, safety personnel and/or any other legally authorised persons representing UEFA Parties or LS VAUD FOOT SA, shall:
  - a. produce a valid Ticket together with proof of identity with valid photograph (passport or national identity card) in order to provide satisfactory evidence that the Ticket Holder's identity corresponds to that of the Applicant/Guest;
  - b. submit to inspections, body checks and examinations (including through the use of technical aids) to ensure that they are not in possession of dangerous, prohibited or unauthorised items. Safety personnel, stewards and/or police shall be entitled to search any person's clothing and their belongings;
  - c. comply with all instructions and guidelines issued by such persons;
  - d. comply with all sanitary measures and policies in place at the Stadium and follow any and all instructions from safety personnel, stewards and/or police and/or any other duly authorised persons at the Stadium in relation to sanitary and hygiene measures; and
  - e. be subject to additional safety controls inside the Stadium, as the case may arise.
- 9.2. It shall be strictly forbidden inside the Stadium to express, display or disseminate of any insulting, discriminatory, racist, xenophobic, sexist, religious, political or other illegal/prohibited messages.

- 9.3. The Stadium Rules contain detailed lists of prohibited items and conduct and each Ticket Holder shall fully comply with any restrictions contained therein. Abbreviated versions of these Terms and Conditions and/or Stadium Rules, or simple icons illustrating prohibited items or conduct, may also be included on the Ticket and must be fully complied with by the Ticket Holder.
- 9.4. Without limitation, it is strictly forbidden to do any of the following inside the Stadium:
- a. occupy or access areas which are closed to the public or for which access is unauthorised in accordance with the relevant Ticket category held by the Ticket Holder;
  - b. restrict or loiter in areas open to traffic, footpaths and roadways, entrances and exits to visitor areas and emergency exits; and/or
  - c. engage in any other conduct which may endanger any person at the Stadium.

The above list is not exhaustive. Ticket Holders should refer to the Stadium Regulations for more information on the required conduct.

- 9.5. Fans supporting the teams participating in the Match may not be segregated at the Stadium and each Ticket Holder agrees to behave responsibly and in line with the safety and security guidelines communicated by UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner.

## **10. Sound and Image Recordings**

- 10.1. Ticket Holders attending the Match take note that their voice, image and likeness recorded during their time in the Stadium ("Recordings") may be used, free of charge, in any image, sound and audiovisual material in connection with the Match, either simultaneously or at a later date. UEFA Parties or third parties engaged or otherwise authorised in each case (e.g., broadcasting, press, individuals/influencers) create Recordings for the purpose and on the basis of their legitimate interest of public reporting and promotion of the Tournament pursuant to Art. 31 para. 1 of the Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection (FADP). Recordings may be processed, exploited and publicly reproduced by UEFA Parties as well as third parties authorised in each case (e.g. broadcasting, press, individuals/influencers) within the scope of the same legitimate interest pursuant to Art. 31 para. 1 of the FADP.
- 10.2. Ticket Holders attending the Match shall not collect, record, use or disseminate any sound, image, recording or depiction of the venue and/or the Match (including any results, statistics, information or other data about the match, in whole or in part) ("Content") over the internet, radio, television or any other current or future media – or assist any other persons in doing so – other than for personal, private and non-commercial use. Any such personal, private and non-commercial use is at the Ticket Holder's own risk and, for the avoidance of doubt, requires the Ticket Holder to clear all necessary rights for such use. Examples of personal, private non-commercial use include sharing (limited) Content (by means of physical or electronic media) with the Ticket Holder's close friends and family but shall not include any use of Content:
- a) on a live/near-live basis;
  - b) in any manner intended to make available any aspect of the match to the public;
  - c) on webpages or social media accounts (save for any closed social media account accessible by the person's close friends and family only);
  - d) to promote, sponsor, endorse or sell products/services;
  - e) to generate any form of commercial gain or remuneration (whether monetary or not);  
or
  - f) on any form of physical or electronic media in any manner that suggests an official association with UEFA Parties and/or the Match.

UEFA Parties reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to determine whether any use of Content constitutes personal, private and non-commercial use. For the avoidance of doubt, UEFA

Parties and any authorised third party is entitled to delete, or cause to be deleted, any images transmitted or publicly displayed in breach of this clause and to bring any other claim against the responsible person (collecting, recording, using or disseminating as described above) in a judicial or extrajudicial proceeding.

- 10.3. All rights in relation to any Content created by Ticket Holders shall be owned by UEFA, save that UEFA Parties hereby grant Ticket Holders a non-exclusive licence to use such Content for the personal, private and non-commercial uses described in Article 10.2 above. In this respect, each Ticket Holder hereby irrevocably and unconditionally transfers and assigns to UEFA Parties, free of charge, all rights (including all intellectual property rights) in relation to any such Content for the full period of such rights. In any jurisdiction where such transfer/assignment does not take effect, the Ticket Holder hereby grants to UEFA Parties, free of charge, a perpetual, worldwide, unrestricted, irrevocable, exclusive, transferable, sub-licensable, royalty-free licence to use such Content for any and all purposes. If requested by UEFA Parties, the Ticket Holder shall do all things reasonably necessary to give effect to this Article 10.3.
- 10.4. To ensure the safety of the public and effective law enforcement, the Stadium and, in part, its surroundings are monitored with a closed-circuit television system in accordance with Art. 31 para. 1 of the FADP generally operated by the Stadium Owner regarding the Match. The respective recordings are treated confidentially by the Stadium Owner and in compliance with applicable data protection law but can serve as evidence in particular in the event of suspicion and/or the occurrence of criminal offences; the Stadium Owner may transfer their recordings to the competent public safety authorities in these cases. In addition, the competent public safety authorities may also use video surveillance equipment on match days on their own responsibility to avert danger and prosecute offenders in accordance with the applicable legal provisions.

## **D. MISCELLANEOUS**

### **11. Liability**

- 11.1. In the event that UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner are in breach of their obligations (under these Terms and Conditions or otherwise), UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner shall only be responsible for such loss or damage suffered by the Ticket Holder which was reasonably foreseeable as a result of the breach. UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner shall not be responsible for any loss or damage that is not reasonably foreseeable or contemplated at the time the Applicant entered into a contract pursuant to these Terms and Conditions.
- 11.2. Notwithstanding Article 11.1 and subject to Article 11.5, UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner are not liable for any business losses and UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner will have no liability to any Ticket Holder for any loss of profit, loss of business, business interruption, or loss of business opportunity.
- 11.3. Subject to Article 11.5, in any event, to the maximum extent permitted by law, UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner hereby exclude any liability for loss, damage or injury to a Ticket Holder and/or their property, including (but not limited to) any indirect or consequential loss or damage, including (but not limited to) loss of enjoyment or travel or accommodation costs, regardless of whether the loss or damage: (a) would arise in the ordinary course of events; (b) is reasonably foreseeable; or (c) is in the contemplation of the parties, or otherwise.
- 11.4. Subject to Article 11.5, UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner shall not be responsible for any interruptions and/or restrictions to the view of the Match caused by virtue of (i) their position at the Stadium and/or (ii) the actions of other spectators.

- 11.5. Notwithstanding any provision in these Terms and Conditions, UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner do not seek to exclude or limit their liability: (a) for fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation; (b) for death or personal injury caused by UEFA Parties' and/or the Stadium Owner's negligence or the negligence of any of their officers, employees or agents; or (c) for any other matter for which it is not possible to exclude or limit liability by law.
- 11.6. Nothing stated or implied in these Terms and Conditions will affect the Ticket Holder's statutory rights.

## **12. Unauthorised Spectators**

- 12.1. Ticket Holders are permitted to attend the Match only provided that:
- a. they are not an Excluded Person (as defined in Article 12.2);
  - b. the Ticket has been obtained in accordance with these Terms and Conditions; and
  - c. where the Ticket Holder travels to the country in which the Tournament is taking place, they have complied with any requirements which are in place regarding entry into such country (including but not limited to any travel and entry requirements, including any requirement to obtain a valid visa, imposed under Applicable Laws).

For the avoidance of doubt, UEFA Parties and/or the Stadium Owner shall not be liable for any loss or damage suffered by a Ticket Holder should they fail to comply with the provisions of this Article 12.1 and/or, where required, fail to obtain the necessary documents.

- 12.2. For the purpose of this Article 12, "Excluded Person" means:
- a. any person banned from membership of the fan club for their national football team;
  - b. any person subject to an administrative or judicial football ban under the Laws of Switzerland;
  - c. any person banned by UEFA, FIFA, any football governing body or otherwise, from travelling to or attending an association football match;
  - d. any person banned by UEFA, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner from attending events at the Stadium;
  - e. any person who is deemed by the participating clubs in the Match to be a person to whom Tickets should not be allocated (including but not limited to persons who have been issued with a stadium ban by the respective participating club);
  - f. any person who is deemed by the relevant public authorities to be a person to whom Tickets should not be allocated for safety and security reasons; and
  - g. any person who has breached or is in breach of these Terms and Conditions.

## **13. Personal data**

- 13.1. Personal data (as defined in Article 3.5) of Applicants and (if applicable) Guests are collected in accordance with the [Privacy Notification](#). All personal data must be true, accurate and complete.

## **14. Unforeseen Circumstances**

- 14.1. UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner reserves the right to make alterations to the time, date and location of the Tournament and/or the Match(es) due to

unforeseen extraordinary circumstances, including but not limited to reasons of force majeure, safety and/or security reasons or other decisions made by any competent authority which have a major impact on the Match(es) being played at the Stadium.

- 14.2. In the event of cancellation, abandonment, rescheduling or replaying of the Match, or in the event of a change of venue, reduction of Stadium capacity or the playing of the relevant Match behind closed doors, the successful Applicant will be bound by the Refund Policy in respect of any refunds of the Tickets purchased by the successful Applicant provided however that:
- a. any refunds may be made only to the successful Applicant (and not to the Guest) and only up to the Purchase Price paid by such successful Applicant for the Ticket(s), and shall not, for the avoidance of doubt, entitle the successful Applicant to a refund of any costs and expenses incurred by the successful Applicant or Guest in relation to travel or accommodation;
  - b. subject to the foregoing and Article 12, UEFA Parties, LS VAUD FOOT SA and/or the Stadium Owner will not have any liability to the successful Applicant or any Guest on account of any such cancellation, abandonment, rescheduling, replay, reduction of Stadium capacity, change of venue or playing of the relevant Match behind closed doors or other failure or deficiency in the conduct of the Match.

## **15. Severability and Amendment**

- 15.1. UEFA Parties reserve the right to change these Terms and Conditions if deemed necessary, including to ensure proper and safe staging of the Match at the Stadium. UEFA Parties will notify each Applicant of any material changes via an email sent to the address indicated by the Applicant in the Application Form and the Applicant will have the choice to consent to such changes or to withdraw their application or withdraw from the agreement concluded with UEFA in accordance with Article 4.1 (as applicable).
- 15.2.
